#### Recruitment

#### RISE Event

Suggestions were made to do three educational sections at the RISE event on the 15<sup>th</sup>. One for marijuana, alcohol, and vape use. The idea of choice for the alcohol breakout is the impairment goggles with the go carts. Pizza will be the option for lunch. Ice Breaker activities and education on RISE and coalitions will also be done with the youth.

### Adult Sectors

We have done a GREAT job recruiting for the adult portion of RISE. Areas left to fill to really round out our group's expertise and capabilities are:

- a. adults from an area of business (a business that is interested in not serving minors, or has a special care for employing substance free employees/youth)
- b. a youth serving organization (say YAC for example)
- c. civic or volunteer group member (Rotary, Kiwanis, ect)
- d. state, local, tribal, or governmental agency (county commissioner, judge, ect.)
- e. Media (someone to help with advertising)

#### Social Media

RISE will eventually make our presence known to the social media world. It was discussed that youth has gotten away from using Facebook, and typically lean toward Instagram. When this is done in the near future, I will create a Facebook and Instagram, as to reach parents and youth with education and events.

## VI. Logic Model

There were many new faces at this meeting. We discussed CADCA, what coalition work entails, and that our work is data driven. Logic models for Otsego County were gone over that include logic models for marijuana, alcohol, and vape use among youth. They start with a Problem Statement, go to the Root Cause (but why?), and end with the Local Condition (but why here?). The vaping logic model is not complete, as key informant and focus group data have not been obtained yet.
