Health Department of Northwest Michigan COVID-19 Update

State of Michigan rescinds emergency orders, vaccination efforts continue

As of tomorrow, June 22, the [State of Michigan emergency orders](#) requiring protective measures will be lifted.

The decision to advance the state ahead of the anticipated schedule is a result of the continued decline in cases and 60.8% of Michigan residents with at least one dose. Similar trends are seen locally in the health department's jurisdiction of Antrim, Charlevoix, Emmet and Otsego counties with significant decreases both in positivity and cases, now at 1.7%, and less than 40 per million per day as well as 62.4% of residents 16 and older having received at least one dose of vaccine.

"Reaching this stage is exciting, but we recognize that our population is growing each day as visitors come to our region," said Lisa Peacock, Health Officer. "This reminds us that vaccinations are our best protection against this virus. For those not yet vaccinated, masking and distancing continue to provide the best protection as we begin to return to normal," she added.

The health department continues to offer vaccination clinics throughout the four-county jurisdiction, in addition to working with local businesses to offer pop-up vaccination clinics. Public health nurses are on site at these events and able to answer any questions that residents may have regarding the vaccines. Johnson & Johnson, Moderna, and Pfizer vaccines are available at all clinics, and they are open to walk-ins or people can register by clicking on the clinic link below.
