MI Safe Start Map highlights significant increase in cases

The Health Department of Northwest Michigan continues to monitor newly diagnosed COVID cases and test positivity rates and is releasing data for Antrim, Charlevoix, Emmet and Otsego counties to demonstrate the spread of the disease in the region.

"These are two of the indicators we follow to assess the trends in the spread of COVID-19 in our community," said Dr. Josh Meyerson, health department medical director. "Below are graphs that demonstrate the rapid increase in cases that began in mid-August and reinforce the need to continue to take measures to reduce the spread through wearing face coverings, avoiding large groups whenever possible, staying home when ill, and frequent handwashing. And, the most important way to prevent the spread of COVID-19 is to get vaccinated."

The graphs are from MI Start Map and apply CDC methodology to the most up to date State of Michigan information, and can be used in accordance with CDC's guidelines. The graphs show weekly cases per 100,000 population and the seven-day COVID-19 positive test rate for Antrim, Charlevoix, Emmet and Otsego counties. Statewide, regional and other county information is available at MI Safe Start Map.

The health department offers convenient COVID-19 vaccination clinics for all area residents and visitors 12 and older either by appointment ahead of time or simply walking in. Parent consent is required for minors. Anyone may call 800-432-4121 if they have questions or are not able to find a time or date that works for them and/or their child. 
Antrim:






Charlevoix:






Emmet:













