This room is available to the community to access books, CareNotes, and other materials regarding loss and grieving, as well as other comfort and healing materials related to loss.





Comfort Care and Support

Helping with end-of-life decisions, grief, and any type of loss

Hospice of Northwest Michigan has been serving our friends and families in northern Michigan for over 40 years. Our caring locally-based staff is trained to meet the immediate needs of our community, caregivers, loved ones, families, and patients. All grief and loss services are provided free of charge to anyone suffering any type of loss.

Counseling Support

Counseling support begins at admission and follows the patient, family and caregivers for 13 months after the death of the patient. It is also provided to the community as needed in response to a loss. The licensed Bereavement/Grief counselor, licensed Medical Social Workers, and Ministerial and Spiritual Advisors all work together as a team to provide assessments, services and support.

Adult Monthly Grief Support Group

Meets once a month in various locations to best support the changing community's needs. This group provides support for any loss, not limited to death (i.e., deployment, loss of a job, loss of a pet, etc.)

Youth Monthly Grief Support Group

Meets once a month in various locations to best support the changing community's needs. Pre-registration and parental consent for participation are required. This program is utilized by our area school counselors and can be customized to best meet the child's needs.

5-week Special Grief Programs

Meets once a week for each 5-week session in various locations. Sessions are held in the winter, spring and fall. Summer sessions are added as needed.

On-site Assisted Living Grief and Loss Support

We are hosted on a monthly basis at various assisted living facilities to assist with losses in that community.

Handling the Holidays

This open community program is scheduled before the holiday season to assist anyone experiencing loss. It is a live, interactive program, offering therapeutic advice, open discussion, coping skills, reference material, and plans, for anyone who is grieving during the holidays.
