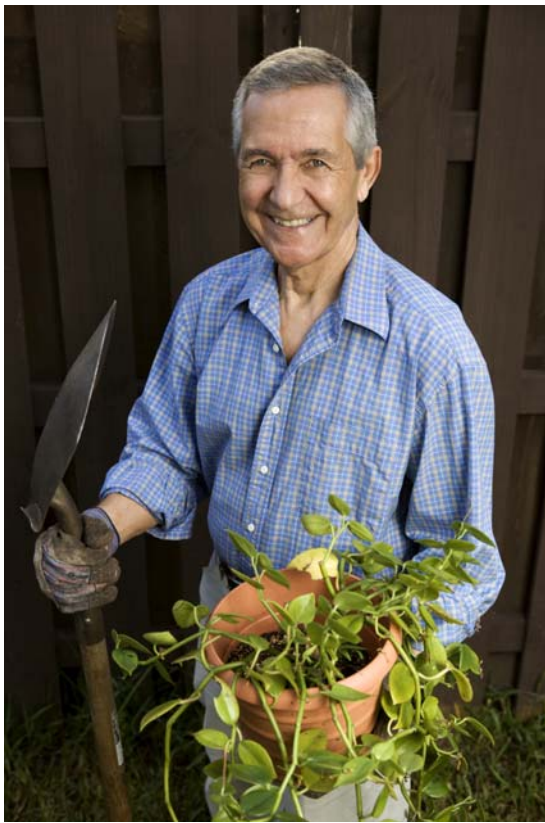

Your Individualized Home Care Team

The home care staff of the Health Department of Northwest Michigan includes registered nurses, home health aides, therapists, and medical social workers. In collaboration with you and your personal physician, our staff develops a unique Plan of Care to help you recover from illness or maintain or improve your independence. A registered nurse or therapist coordinates your care, making regular visits to your home and communicating with other staff and your physician.

We offer experienced, caring staff for

Skilled Nursing Care

Our nurses provide evaluation and on-going monitoring of your condition, as well as wound care, IV therapy, medication management, and clinical education so you are able to independently manage your care needs.

Assistance in Negotiating the Health Care System

Our staff coordinates with local health care providers to obtain medical supplies and equipment, referrals, and access community resources.

Rehabilitation

Our therapists assist you to gain maximum mobility to increase or maintain your level of independence in performing daily activities of living.

Basic Personal Care

Health care aides assist in meeting your personal care needs by providing assistance with bathing, shampooing, dressing, and changing linens.

Financial Assistance, Counseling, and Access to Additional Community Resources

A medical social worker assesses social and emotional needs, provides financial counseling, personal counseling, assistance in planning care alternatives, and assists individuals and families to access appropriate community resources.
