- Ages 19-64
- Not currently enrolled in Medicaid or Medicare
- Within income criteria (See *Income Guidelines on reverse side.*)

The Healthy Michigan Plan includes the following Essential Health Benefits:

- Doctor office visits and outpatient services
- Emergency services
- Hospitalization
- Home Help & Personal Care services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Mental health and substance abuse
- Prescription drugs
- Rehabilitative services
- Dental and vision
- Laboratory
- Preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management

The Healthy Michigan Plan will cover other medically necessary services as appropriate.

You'll need these items for yourself, and for each person in your household needing coverage:

- Social Security Number
- Employer Name (if employed)
- Current Health Insurance Policy Numbers (if insured)
- Paycheck Stubs or W-2 Form

You'll also be asked if employer-provided health insurance is available to anyone in your household. Legal immigrants will need immigration document numbers.

Prior to applying for health coverage, call your primary care physician's office to find out which health insurance plans they accept.



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
