The Healthy Kids plan covers women during pregnancy and the first two months after pregnancy ends.

**Pregnant Women Coverage Includes:**

- ✓ Check-ups (prenatal care) and prenatal vitamins before your baby is born
- ✓ Hospital care
- ✓ Lab & x-ray tests
- ✓ Delivery (birth) of your baby
- ✓ Care for your baby after birth
- ✓ Other Healthy Kids-covered services

**When applying you must:**

- ✓ Be a citizen of the US
- ✓ Declare income
- ✓ Be a resident of Michigan
- ✓ Tell us if you have medical insurance
- ✓ Meet the income requirements

**MICHild covers:**

- ✓ Regular check-ups
- ✓ Immunizations (shots)
- ✓ Emergency care
- ✓ Dental care
- ✓ Pharmacy
- ✓ Hospital care
- ✓ Prenatal care and delivery
- ✓ Vision and Hearing
- ✓ Mental health and substance abuse services

MICHild covers other services, too. Your health plan will give you the full list when your coverage begins. If your child qualifies, you pay a monthly premium of \$10. Even if you have more than 1 child you pay only \$10 a month.

**How can I get MICHild?**

- ✓ Be a citizen of the US
- ✓ Be a resident of Michigan
- ✓ Be under 19 years old
- ✓ Have no other health insurance
- ✓ Meet the income requirements
