Who Can Receive Healthy Families Northern Michigan Support?

Expectant parents and parents of newborns may qualify for free visits.

How Does Healthy Families Northern Michigan Work?

HFNM home visitors may begin seeing you when you are pregnant and can continue visits until your child is four years of age.
